No context switching

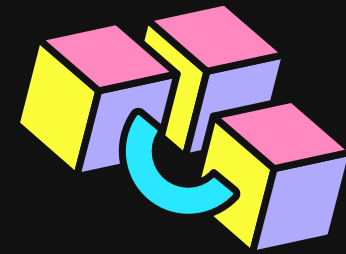

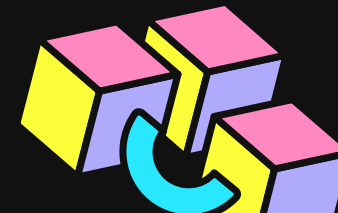
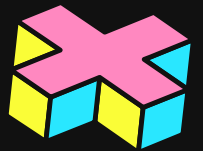
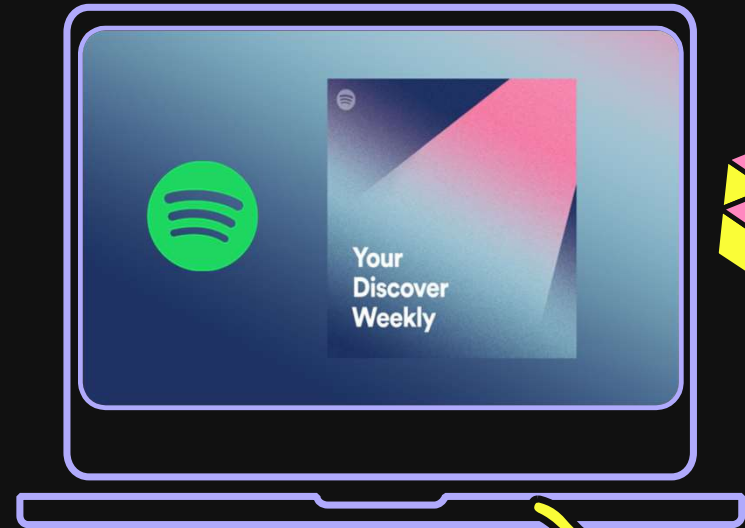
Why do hackathons work?

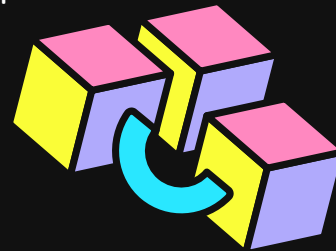

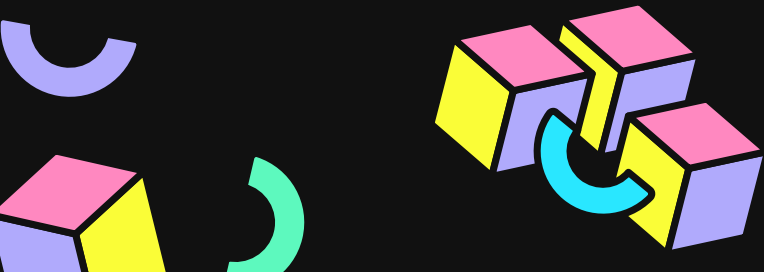
